COVID-19 Update

Dear Family and Friends of South Cove Manor:

Yesterday we completed another round of targeted outbreak testing of all staff and residents that were potentially exposed to our most recent positive staff member. Thankfully all results were negative. Today we conduct our weekly surveillance testing of all staff members. We anticipate having those results back over the weekend, and I will share those with you as soon as we receive them.

Our one positive resident has very mild symptoms that continue to improve. Both the positive resident and the resident's roommate are in separate rooms by themselves and isolated from others.

Yesterday, we had one previously positive staff member return to work. In addition, we also have two additional previously positive staff members retuning today. Those retuning staff members brings our total number of staff members that are excluded from work while they recover down to 6. We anticipate having all of the 6 remaining excluded staff back in the building by Monday, January 17th. A breakdown of where in the building the currently excluded staff members work is below:

First Floor: 1 Second Floor: 2

Third Floor: 1 Support staff: 2 Visitation continues to be allowed at South Cove, but please be aware that in any setting, the risk of being exposed to COVID-19 remains. As a result, there are specific protocols that still must be adhered to by all visitors:

Masks must be worn at all times while in the building

All visitors must be screened upon arrival.

Visitors need to go directly from the reception desk to the resident's room they are visiting (If all visitors, the resident being visited, and roommate are vaccinated). If any one of those people are not vaccinated, the visit must occur at the visitation stations in the activity room.

Visitors are not permitted to congregate in public areas, or to enter resident rooms other than the room of the resident they are visiting.

Visitors are not allowed to eat with the resident but can be present during the meal.

COVID-19更新

親愛的中华颐养院的家人和朋友:

昨天,我們完成了對所有可能接觸到我們最近呈陽性的工作人員的所有工作人員和居民的另一輪有針對性的爆發測試。所有結果都是陰性的。今天,我們每週對所有員工進行常规測試。我們預計將在周末取回這些結果,我會在收到結果後立即與您分享。

我們的一位陽性居民的症狀非常輕微,且還在繼續改善。陽性的院民和 其室友各自在不同的房間,與他人隔離。 昨天,我們有一名阳性工作人員重返工作崗位。此外,我們今天還有另外兩名阳性工作人員重新調整。這些重新調整的員工使我們在康復期間被排除在工作之外的員工總數減少到 6 人。我們預計在 1 月 17 日星期一之前,剩下的 6 名被排除在外的員工全部回到大樓。目前被排除在外的工作人員在大樓中的工作地點細分如下:

一樓: 1 二樓: 2 三樓: 1

后勤人员: 2

中华颐养院繼續允許探視,但請注意,在任何環境中,暴露於 COVID-19 的風險仍然存在。因此,所有訪問者仍必須遵守特定協議: 在大樓內必須始終佩戴口罩

所有訪客必須在抵達時接受檢查。

訪客需要直接從接待處前往他們正在探訪的住戶房間(如果所有訪客、 被探訪的住戶和室友都接種了疫苗)。如果其中任何人未接種疫苗,則 必須在活動室的探視站進行探視。

訪客不得聚集在公共區域,或進入他們正在訪問的住戶房間以外的住戶 房間。

訪客不得與居民一起用餐,但可以在用餐期間在場。


